PREVIOUS BUSINESS:

1) Ordinance No. 2009- 105 An Ordinance Authorizing The City Manager To Execute An Agreement With Buckeye Lawn And Landscaping

Abstract

This legislation will approve an agreement with Buckeye Lawn and Landscaping to provide mowing of public right-of-ways and perform routine maintenance of certain city-owned facilities and parks for calendar year 2010. The cost of this contract is \$106,600.

3) Ordinance No. 2009-109 An Ordinance Amending Section 913.03 Of the Codified Ordinances Relating To Sanitary Sewers

This legislation will approve a sanitary sewer rate increase of 3% effective January 1, 2010.

4) Ordinance No. 2009-110 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 133 Of The Codified Ordinances Providing For Employment Provisions, And Declaring An Emergency
